SECTION B SCOPE OF WORKS

INTRODUCTION OF THE PROJECT

THE SCOPE OF WORKS ENTAILS: TAKING OF WATER AND WASTE WATER SAMPLES AT PREDETERMINED SAMPLING POINTS WITHIN THE HARRY GWALA DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY, PRESERVING THE SAMPLES ACCORDINGLY WHILST TRANSPORTING THEM AN ACCREDITED LABORATORY FOR ANALYSIS. SAMPLERS ARE TO CONDUCT OPERATIONAL SAMPLING IN EACH SAMPLE SITE. THE CONTRACT WILL BE AS AND WHEN REQUIRED BY THE MUNICIPALITY FOR THE PERIOD OF 36 MONHTS.

1. SCOPE OF WORK

In awarding this Tender, Harry Gwala District Municipality expects the Services Provider to be responsible for following:

Item 1.	Description of work Taking Water and Wastewater Samples
1.1	- Site visit to all sample site as per the sampling schedule
1.2	- Attend sampling training from an accredited laboratory
1.3	 Collect weekly sampling schedule and sampling bottles with labels from an accredited laboratory
1.4	- Conduct operational sampling in each sample site
1.5	 Take water and wastewater samples at the predetermined sampling point/site within HGDM
1.6	 Preserve samples accordingly whilst transporting them to an accredited laboratory for analysis
1.7	 Submit Operational monitoring reports weekly to Water Services Internal Laboratory
1.8	- Conduct resampling as and when required by Water Services
1.9	- Submit Compliance Monitoring Report

2. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- 2.1 Service Provider information should be registered to Harry Gwala District Municipality Database.
- 2.2 Service provider must have previous experience in projects of similar nature.
- 2.3 No costs, apart from the costs specified in this document, will be accepted or allowed to be charged to either Service provider, the Service Provider must ensure that all other costs are covered in the tender.
