

SECTION B SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE TECHNICAL RACE DIRECTOR

Introduction

Harry Gwala District Municipality is looking for a Technical Race Director for Harry Gwala District Marathon

Background

The Harry Gwala District Municipality will be hosting its 9th annual Marathon on the 31st of March 2024. The starting point of the marathon this year will be at UMzimkhulu in Ibisi and the finishing point will be at Ixopo High School. This Marathon is hosted in line with the spirit of promoting sport, social cohesion, tourism, and a healthy lifestyle, it is also a comrades qualifier.

The marathon is an event that required technical knowledge and experience in organizing and managing all activities to ensure safety of the athletes as well as adherence to all required standards of a road running event.

It is against this background that a Technical Race Director is being sorted to assist the district in managing the race.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Manage all activities of the race on behalf of the district.
 - Prepare a detailed project plan for the whole race in consultation with all key stakeholders
 - Present detailed written reports to the ROC on responsibilities to be aligned in the Terms of Reference
 - Provide guidance to the Race Organising Committee (ROC)
 - Manage and liaise with referees and appoint other technical officials needed for the race
 - Educate, manage and guide all portfolio managers
 - Oversee and report to the ROC on the training of all marshals and refreshment table assistants
 - Payment of public liability insurance cover that is adequate for 5000 people
 - Ensure the entire race is technically compliant to the KZN Athletics standards
 - Appointment and management of safety officer
 - Oversee the flow of activities from the starting points (42.2kms, 21.1kms and 10kms).
 - Manage the flow of all activities as well as prize giving event at the finishing point.
 - Prepare a closeout report for presentation and handover to the ROC during the Post-mortem meeting.

NB: All details regarding the ROC meetings, Portfolio managers to be confirmed with the District Project Manager. Confirmation of number of Referees, technical Officials, readiness of marshalls, Public liability, Technical compliance of the race, appointment of the safety officer to be confirmed in the ROC meeting 5 days before the date of the race.

- Ensure official marketing of the race
 - Engage and liaise with relevant avenues/individuals to market the race
 - Handle and manage use of District potential to ensure that the race is rated accordingly to attract athletes

NB: Concrete proof of engagements with key stakeholders / influencers for marketing the race and ensuring highest standard is attained.

- Manage on-the-day activities of the race
 - Provide starting pistol, race timer and pellets
 - Manage prize giving ceremony
 - Hire and pay route and finish technical managers
 - Manage start and finish layout

NB: Pistol, race timer and pellets to be provided and confirmed with District Project Manager on Saturday the 30th of March 2024 Detailed layout of the Price Giving Ceremony Program to be discussed and confirmed with the ROC 5 days before the race. Draft layout of the start and finish be discussed with the ROC 5 days before the race and finalisation confirmed with District Project Manager by Saturday the 30th of March 2024.

Conclusion

It should be noted that Genius Club is in partnership with the district in this initiative and have specific responsibilities; and the Technical Race Director will with The Club within the ROC whilst having a clear responsibility to:

- Guide all proceedings for the race,
- Liaise and guide all stakeholders through the Harry Gwala District Municipality Project Manager
